Quail Ridge Lodge



The 3,600-square foot Quail Ridge Lodge accommodates up to 180 guests for wedding receptions, organization banquets, family parties, and other festive events. The single-floor facility has a large, vaulted ceiling and a wooden deck that overlooks a nearby lake and gazebo. It comes equipped with a warming kitchen that contains a range / oven (not capable of cooking food, but only warming food up), microwave, refrigerator / freezer, and sink. Tables and chairs are included with the rental, but linens and decorations are not provided.

The Quail Ridge Lodge is located in Quail Ridge Park. To check facility availability and make a reservation for the Quail Ridge Lodge, <u>register</u> online or call the Parks Department at 636-949-7535.

Reservation Terms

Once a facility reservation for the Quail Ridge Lodge or the Curt Loupe Conference Center is requested, the guest has 5 business days to return the signed permit or agree to the terms of rental online, and pay the facility rental fee, and the damage deposit. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the facility reservation request.

Any guest reserving the Quail Ridge Lodge or the Curt Loupe Conference Center will be responsible for check in and check out procedures with a park ranger, unless other arrangements are made prior to the reservation date. Please return the key to the ranger at check out.

Rental Fee

- Monday Thursday Full Day: \$650
- Weekends and Holidays Full Day: \$800
- Refundable Damage Deposit on all rentals: \$250

Reservation Information

- Reservations: Can book up to 2 years out.
- Tables and Chairs are available with rental and may not be taken out onto deck or gazebo area.

 Select Language

- Alcohol: Kegs must be approved by director prior to event via the special use form. No cash bar allowed without proof of liquor license.
- Decorations: Decorations must be freestanding only. Items may not be attached or hung from the walls or ceiling. No candles with open flames allowed. You may not put lights in or on the trees but you may drape or wrap lights around the deck railing. You must remove all decorations at the end of event.
- Clean-up: No trash on grounds around building or parking lot, tables
 and chairs must be left clean, responsible for taking down all
 decorations, no marks on walls / floors, restrooms checked, all
 kitchen appliances cleaned out and wiped down, large spills are
 cleaned up and all trash is bagged, tied and placed in roll away
 dumpster in back of building.
- Rental times: Rental times include set up and clean up.
 - Full Day: 9 a.m. 11 p.m.
 - Check out: 11 p.m.
- Refunds: No refunds will be given for inclement weather or cancellations made 90 days or less from reservation date.
 Cancellations made prior to 90 days will receive a refund less a 15% administrative fee.
- Closed: Christmas Day and New Year's Eve; it closes at 6 p.m. on Thanksgiving and Christmas Eve; and the facility is open and available for rental on New Year's Day.

The visitors center features a spacious back porch outside that overlooks Betty's Lake and a grand fireplace inside. If you're looking for a unique space to host your next special event, family function, or staff meeting, check out the large meeting room that is situated inside the visitors center. The meeting room seats 50 guests comfortably and comes equipped with a microwave, refrigerator, freezer, and sink. Tables and chairs for are included with the rental, but linens and decorations are not provided. Reserve the meeting room from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. for \$100 per day with a \$100 damage deposit. The visitors center is closed Christmas Day and New Year's Eve; it will close at 6 p.m. on Thanksgiving and Christmas Eve; and the facility is open and available for rental on New Year's Day.
