Located on the main floor of the Museum of Art, the Carnegie Cafe is a space of simple sophistication. One side of the café has floor-to-ceiling glass walls where guests can look out onto the front patio and decorative fountain outside.

### **Scaife Foyer**

### **Carnegie Museum of Art Theater**

### Hall of Sculpture

Distinguished by a double tier of columns, the hall is modeled after the Parthenon's inner sanctuary. The space is constructed with brilliant white marble from the same quarries in Greece that provided the stone for the Parthenon.




## Foster Overlook/ *Dinosaurs* in Their Time

#### Hillman Hall and Lobby

New acquisitions are added to the collection on an ongoing basis.


### **Carnegie Music Hall Foyer**

Added in 1907, the dramatic Music Hall Foyer boasts a soaring 50 foot ceiling of gilded baroque décor, supported by pillars of marble from five different countries. In addition, an ornate metal balcony overlooks this elegant space.

#### Founder's Room

### **Carnegie Music Hall**
